AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Allegation in this petition is that the petitioner had purchased Bajaj Platina motorcycle, whereas in the papers which have been prepared, it is alleged that the petitioner had signed in Punjabi, whereas he only thumb-marks the papers as he is illiterate. Counsel for the petitioner states that on the basis of the documents which were submitted by the petitioner, it was shown that the petitioner had bought Discover motorcycle, whereas he had in his possession Platina motorcycle. Apart from that, the documents which have been submitted by the petitioner, have been misused for opening an account in his name with his forged signatures in Punjabi by respondent No.6 and the account has been opened in Indusind Bank Ltd., Branch Kaula Park near Vodafone Office, Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had earlier submitted a representation dated 05.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) to the Director, Vigilance, Punjab, but no action has been taken. He further states that the petitioner shall now submit a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, within a period of two weeks, highlighting his grievance in detail, which may be looked into by the said officer.

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, in case the petitioner submits a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur-respondent No.3, within a period of two weeks, the same shall be considered and if some substance is found therein, further action in accordance with law be taken.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
