This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against respondent No.4 on the complaint dated 3.10.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Serious allegations has been levelled in the complaint but it is asserted that the police is not taking any action without any cogent reason.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar respondents No.2 to consider and decide complaint (Annexure P-4) within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. He is further directed to submit status report before concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.
