FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose off a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the FIR 90 dated 20.06.2017 registered under Sections 199, 200, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 494 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

Report dated 17.09.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received to the effect that statements of accused Gaurav Handa as well as petitioners Ashwani Handa, Rose Mary, Ritesh Handa and Shivani Handa through special attorney Gaurav Handa recorded whereas statement of complainant Bhawna could not be recorded as she did not turn up.

Complainant Bhawna and the accused/petitioner Gaurav Handa have come present in compliance of the orders of this Court and made statements on oath recorded separately that they have

compromised the matter out of their free will, accord and without any undue influence or duress.

Heard.

Upon interacting with the parties, this Court is of the view that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure and considering the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 90 dated 20.06.2017 registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana under Sections 199, 200, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 494 and 120-B IPC and all consequences arising out therefrom qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
