By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.25 dated 2.2.2018 registered under Sections 307, 342, 336, 457, 380, 447, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Phagwara, District Kapurthala and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 1.6.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Phagwara has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant Jinderpal and also of injured Amanpreet Singh have been recorded, who both have stated that the matter has been amicably resolved with the accused and that they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

It has specifically been opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.25 dated 2.2.2018 registered under Sections 307, 342, 336, 457, 380, 447, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Phagwara, District Kapurthala and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
