Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and further directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct impartial inquiry against the respondents No.4 to 6 as per the averments of the representations (Annexures P-1 to P-3).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

The representation (Annexure P-2) shows that the matter is purely of civil in nature, but the petitioner has tried to give it a picture of threat to his life and liberty.

Without commenting anything on the claim so projected, the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur is directed to look into the threat perception, if any.
