Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of Complaint No. 775/2015, Registration No.80/2015 dated 01.09.2014, RT No.102 dated 01.09.2014 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 506 and 34 IPC, at Police Station- Sadar Kotkapura, Faridkot and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 24.09.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 06.10.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned District and Sessions Judge, Faridkot has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.3174/EB, dated 11.10.2018.

According to the report, learned District and Sessions Judge, Faridkot, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, without any pressure or undue influence and in favour of the parties to live with peace and harmony. No accused has been declared proclaimed offender.

Considering the report of learned District and Sessions Judge, Faridkot, dated 11.10.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid Complaint No. 775/2015, Registration No.80/2015 dated 01.09.2014, RT No.102 dated 01.09.2014 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 506 and 34 IPC, at Police Station- Sadar Kotkapura, Faridkot and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/-, out of which Rs.4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Rs.1,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs.5,000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Legal Services Committee within one week from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
