Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for quashing order dated 01.06.2017 of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari and order dated 08.09.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rewari, whereby criminal complaint No.40 dated 17.02.2011 of the petitioner under Sections 193, 466, 467, 468, 469 and 471 IPC, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that both the Courts below failed to appreciate that respondent No.2 got himself appointed as Lambardar on fake documents, ignoring cogent and convincing evidence led by the petitioner.

Having given thoughtful consideration to the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds no merit in the instant petition for the reasons to follow.

No question of law, much less substantial has been raised

in the petition.

There are concurrent findings of both the Courts below

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against the petitioner.

Filing of the present petition by the petitioner is whimsical action of the petitioner to satisfy his whims and fantasies by harassing respondent No.2, who got success in his appointment as Lambardar by getting the candidature of respondent No.2 rejected.

Dismissed.
