Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 35 dated 14.2.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452, 427, 506, 307 and 120B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI Mehroof Ali, has pointed out that there are as many as six more cases against the petitioner; despite the fact that he is a uniformed person, serving as a constable in the police. He further submits that the petitioner is the main conspirator behind the incident. The police is yet to investigate the case in its right earnest.

Since the investigation of the case is yet to be taken in its right earnest, therefore, this Court does not find any ground to prevent the police from investigating the case in a proper manner. No extra-ordinary circumstances are disclosed by the petitioner for exercising extra-ordinary

power under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
