The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the complaint/representation dated 25.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondent Nos. 4 to 6, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mrs. Anju Arora, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of four weeks, on receipt

of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the complaint/representation dated 25.04.2018. (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
