INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Mandeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.222 dated 07.11.2017, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Patiala, District Patiala, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR has been registered on the basis of application given by complainants-Jagdev Singh and Harjinder Singh. As per the allegations in the FIR, one Anu Sharma, Journalist, Tavinder Singh Panesar alias Sonu, Journalist and Mandeep Singh Grewal @ Ravi(present petitioner) conspired together and committed fraud of ₹16 lakhs by inducing that they will get the complainants selected as police constables.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that money is still to be recovered, I find that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
