This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate direction to the official respondents to submit the status report in FIR No. 0203 dated 22.04.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 34, 354 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra.

Upon notice, status report, by way of affidavit of Mr. Raj Singh, HPS, DSP, Head Quarter, Kurukshetra, has been filed on behalf of official respondents in which it is submitted that investigation has been conducted and a challan has been presented on 17.07.2017 against respondents No. 4 and 5 and, therefore, the instant petition has become infructuous.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a

threat perception because the petitioner herein is still facing harassment at the hands of the private respondents herein.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. The petitioner is directed to file a fresh representation, regarding any harassment faced at the hands of the private respondents, to respondent No. 2 herein who will duly consider the said representation in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month on receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of.
