FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Report dated 26.07.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Bhawna and the accused persons, namely, Ashwani Handa, Manju Handa, Ritesh Handa, Gaurav Handa, Amanat Ansari and Ram Moorti, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of**

Punjab and another' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and 'Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 18 dated 25.01.2017 registered at Police Station Division 5, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana under Sections 177, 199, 200, 419, 420 and 120-B IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
