The present petition has been filed with prayer to issue direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to secure the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members as he apprehends false implication at the hands of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.5 has been indicted on earlier occasions also for falsely implicating various persons. He has referred to order annexures P2 and P3, in this regard. In this case also, the said respondent is victimizing the petitioner and a representation dated 30.04.2018 (Annexure P1) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion. Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent No.5, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P1) and in case it is found

necessary, the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members be protected. Departmental action be also taken against respondent No.5 after granting an opportunity of hearing to him, if it is felt that he is mis-using his authority. The needful be done within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
