The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.119 dated 25.04.2018, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana.

It is a case of the prosecution that the petitioner alongwith his two associates namely Sonu Arora and Deepak Kharbanda duped huge amount of Rs.13,00,000/- from the complainant. It is asserted that the petitioner was earlier a tenant in the house of complainant and he introduced remaining two accused to the complainant. The said amount was received from the complainant on the pretext of sending him to Japan but he was taken to Bangkok and fake visa for Japan was arranged

After going through the material available on record, this Court is of the view that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary. Therefore, no ground to grant him the benefit of anticipatory bail to him is made out.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
