Present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR no. 224 dated 6.4.2018, registered under Sections 307, 379, 429 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 13(1) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act 2015 and under Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty of Animals Act, 1960 at Police Station Sector 55, District Faridabad, Haryana.

Heard.

Petitioners are alleged to be the members of a gang, which were found by the police to have killed three cows and one bull. When the Police officials conducted the raid, two of the members of the said unlawful assembly attacked the police with an axe and knife. However, no body was injured. Petitioners had ran away from the spot. Though one of the said member of the unlawful assemble was arrested at the spot.

Learned State counsel has opposed the anticipatory bail of the petitioners on the ground that petitioners are suspected to be indulging in cow slaughter for the last 10 years. They also might be involved in other criminal activities and their custodial interrogation is necessary.

It being so, it is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the present petitioners.

Dismissed.
