Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.60 dated 24.02.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, 395, 397 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhupani, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 01.06.2018 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Reply by way of affidavit of Atma Ram, HPS Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Faridabad, filed in court today on behalf of respondent No.1-State, is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Surat Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid facts and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage. He further states that though there is a reference that the matter

has been compromised between the parties, but it is not in the notice of the police.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Be that as it may, since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 01.06.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
