The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 148, dated 17.12.2016, under Sections 307, 341, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he has caused blow with an iron rod on left arm of the complainant. He contends that co-accused, Pavitar Singh @ Gollu, who was armed with Gandasa, gave a blow on the head of the complainant and was granted anticipatory bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM No. M-20289 of 2018 on 15.05.2018 as the matter has been compromised. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for almost a month since 11.05.2018 and has referred to the copy of the compromise deed, which has been annexed as Annexure P-2.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when co-accused, Pavitar Singh @ Gollu has been granted anticipatory bail and the petitioner is in custody for over one month, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Balkar Singh @ Balkari is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
