ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. aggrieved by the order dated 23.05.2018, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge who declined to accord permission to the petitioner to travel abroad to see his mother in Canada.

I have heard the counsel for the petitioner at great length.

The counsel for the petitioner had stated that the petitioner had surrendered in the Court on 08.11.2016 and he was allowed bail by the High Court on 31.10.2017. It was also submitted that the mother of the petitioner had been acquitted in 2015 in this FIR and thereafter she had gone abroad.

A case was registered against the petitioner wherein allegations of kidnapping and rape were made in 1999. The petitioner fled the country. He was declared proclaimed offender on 23.11.2001.

The petitioner wants to travel abroad to meet his mother who is stated to be sick and ailing. The petitioner had fled the country and had avoided the law for 17 years. He had surrendered only in November 2016. He cannot be permitted to go abroad as the second chance cannot be given to him considering his past conduct. The trial Court would endeavor to complete the trial as expeditiously as it can.

The petition is dismissed limine.
