AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that a complaint was submitted by the petitioner on 09.04.2018 against Sanjeev Arora son of late Shri S.C. Arora-respondent No.4, alleging forgery and getting blank papers signed by him by entering his house. The said complaint is pending consideration before the Economic Offences Wing, Chandigarh. After the submission of the said complaint, respondent No.4-Sanjeev Arora is threatening and browbeating the petitioner for withdrawal of the said complaint. Highlighting this aspect, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 10.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) to the Inspector General of Police, U.T. Chandigarh, with a copy thereof to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, but till date, nothing has been done thereon.

Counsel states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No.3, to look into the representation of the petitioner and take steps in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting

thereon, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the

Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 10.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner and if need be, take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
