KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 1337 dated 30.12.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 216 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

Heard.

It comes out that petitioner is an accused of committing the murder of Jaidev Sharma.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application on the ground that Jaidev Sharma-deceased was the police informer. As a result of information supplied by him encounter took place in which the leader of the gang of the present petitioner was killed in the police encounter. Later on, petitioner gang murdered Jaidev Sharma. Now the said gang is threatening the police officers and even the security has been provided to the police

officers.

It is contended that petitioner is the member of the deadly gang operating in Haryana and if he is released on bail, he is likely to indulge in criminal activities and endanger public safety.

Keeping in view the serious allegations levelled against the present petitioner, no ground to release him on bail is made out.

Dismissed.
