The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing direction to respondent No.2 to ensure the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.3 to 7.

Notice of motion was issued in the matter and a reply has been filed by the respondent-State by way of affidavit of ASI Baljinder Singh, Police Station NRI Bathinda, in which it is submitted that after the registration of the FIR, an enquiry was conducted that complainant Yaslin stayed with Harmanpreet Kaur and Amanpreet Kaur only for nine days and during this period, no complaint regarding threat and demand of dowry had been made, therefore, they have been declared innocent. It is further submitted that after getting approval from Inspector General of Police, an FIR No.2 dated 09.01.2017, under Sections 420, 498-A, 406, 506, 120-B of

Indian Penal Code, has been registered at Police Station NRI Bathinda against Gurpreet Singh, Surinder Kaur and Jasveer Singh.

I have heard learned counsel for the respondent-State and have also perused the reply filed.

In view of the fact that the petitioners herein have been found innocent and challan has only been presented only against Gurpreet Singh, Surinder Kaur and Jasveer Singh, no further orders are called for in the matter.

The petition in hand stands disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
