The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.258 dated 18.10.2017, registered at Police Station E-Division Amritsar, District Amritsar, under Sections 379-B/411IPC.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been in custody since 18.10.2017. Investigation is complete and the complainant has also been examined. However, the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and therefore, the petitioner be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Baljeet Singh does not dispute the aforementioned factual position.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner-Vishal Bhatti, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
