On 22.01.2018, following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner entered into agreement to sell with Iqbal Singh in respect of plot in question on 14.07.2017 on the basis of document of title in the form of civil Court decree obtained by Iqbal Singh from his father Harbans Lal. The jamabandi showed Iqbal Singh to be owner of the plot in question. On that premise, the petitioner got his electricity connection in a room situated in the said plot. The agreement could not fructify and stood vitiated, however, electric connection remained in the name of the petitioner for which proceedings are pending.

Notice of motion for 15.03.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 28.01.2018 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance to the aforesaid order, the petitioner submitted that petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel further submitted that when the agreement between petitioner and Iqbal Singh could not fructify, the petitioner has nothing to do with the electricity connection in question.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Krishan Kumar.

In view of the above, interim order dated 22.01.2018 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
