This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 53 dated 4.2.2018 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 325 added later on and Section 3(1) (r) of SC/ST Act at Police Station Farakpur District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was arrested on 11.3.2018.

Learned State counsel submits that challan has already been presented and two of the co-accused have already been released on bail by this Court.

Since the disposal of the case will take time, there is no justification for further detention of the present petitioner. As such, present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his

furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs 30,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamunanagar at Jagadhari.
