G.S. SANDHAWALIA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has filed the petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. and seeks regular bail in FIR No.133 dated 24.09.2017 under Section 306 of IPC, at P.S. Moonak, District Sangrur.

The deceased was Makhan Singh and as per the suicide note he had leveled allegations against accused Charanjit Kaur, Ranjit Kaur (petitioner in the present case), Jaswinder Kaur, Baljinder Doctor, Jagsir Singh @ Jaggi Singh and Gurjeet Kaur and apart from these three more persons. The grouse was that they would involve him in a rape case and to procure money at pistol point.

Counsel for the State has contended that Jaswinder Kaur was released on anticipatory bail by this Court on 14.12.2017, thereafter Baljinder Singh, Jagsir Singh alias Jaggi and Gurjeet Kaur were also released on regular bail by this Court vide orders dated 09.05.2018 and 17.05.2018, respectively.

From the order passed in case of Gurjeet Kaur it would go on to show that FSL report regards the suicide note had not been

received.

Counsel for the State has now submitted that the said report has been received as such.

In such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner is entitled for parity since the issue of abetment would also always be primary question to be considered at the time of trial. The bail application is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to furnishing of adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
