Learned counsel for respondent No.6 stated that he does not want any mediation and he has no objection if the petition is allowed.

Heard both the parties.

The prayer in the petition is for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner by stating that the petitioner is being harassed on frivolous complaint on account of matrimonial dispute with respondent No.6. Further prayer is made that in any case, the petitioner or his family members are required for any enquiry, they be issued advance notice and fair enquiry should be conducted.

Learned State counsel stated that they will conduct fair enquiry

to find out the actual truth.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-State not to un-necessary harass the petitioner and his family members by required them to police station repeatedly. In case, they are required they will be issued due notice by giving sufficient time and the enquiry should be in transparent manner to find out the actual truth. It is stated that enquiry is being conducted by Mr. Ramandeep Singh, DSP and the prayer is that the enquiry should be conducted by some other officer.

In the circumstances, the Senior Superintendent of Police, is directed to appoint any other officer for conducting the enquiry except Mr. Ramandeep Singh, DSP. It is further directed that newly appointed DSP shall hear the version and see the documents submitted by both the parties while deciding the enquiry.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
