Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.8 dated 17.01.2018 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of present petition, matter has been compromised between the parties and an amount of Rs.19.5 lakhs has been paid to the complainant- Pushpa Gogia.

Learned counsel for the complainant on instructions from Parkash Chand Gogia, husband of complainant Pushpa Gogia, has fairly admitted that the complainant has received an amount of Rs.19.5 lakhs from

the petitioner through his father and as on date, nothing is outstanding.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the statements of Santosh Kumari, Pushpa Gogia and Satpal Singh wherein they have admitted the factum of compromise dated 09.08.2018 entered between the parties.

Since the counsel for the respondent-complainant has not disputed the payment, the order dated 10.08.2018 whereby the petitioner had been admitted on interim bail, is made absolute.

Accordingly, present petition is disposed of.
