Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 7 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.2, S.H.O., Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur-respondent No.3 and S.H.O., Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur-respondent No.4, respectively.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3, to look into the representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.2 and S.H.O., Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur-respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
