Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.164 dated 11.05.2018 under Sections 420/466/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

2.) This Court vide order dated 04.06.2018 had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the arresting/Investigation Officer, petitioners were ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting/Investigating Officer.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 04.06.2018, petitioners

appeared before the arresting/Investigating Officer and joined the investigation. It is further submitted that petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 04.06.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. Petitioners shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) The petitioners shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and they shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Petition stands allowed.
