In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.173 dated 29.12.2017, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is in custody since 29.12.2017 and challan has been filed. He also relies on decision in identical circumstances in the case titled as ***Hitesh Kumar @ Ashu versus State of Punjab***, passed in CRM-M-25787 of 2017 decided on 25.01.2018. Therefore, petitioner is entitled for regular bail in terms of the order passed in above mentioned petition.

3. Heard

4. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner,

especially having regard to the fact that petitioner is in custody since 29.12.2017 read with judgment dated 25.01.2018 and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

5. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Inderjit Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
