Petitioner-Gurlal Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.16 dated 18.01.2017, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 285, 506, 307 and 379-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is stated to be armed with pistol and fired a shot from it, but it did not hit to anybody. No injury has been declared dangerous to life in this case. Two simple injuries with reverse side of *gandasa* are also attributed to the present petitioner.

He has been in custody since 15.10.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. Six witnesses are still to be examined and trial of the case will take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
