The present appeal directs challenge against award dated 21.01.1998 passed by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Sangrur (in short, 'the Tribunal') whereby compensation has been awarded on account of death of Harjinder Singh son of Shri Ajit Singh in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 03.03.1995.

Counsel for the appellant has submitted that the appeal has been preferred by the insurance company only on the question of driving licence possessed by Pritpal Singh, driver of the offending vehicle, being not valid. It is argued that the insurance company has filed an application under Order 41 Rule 27 of the Code of Civil Procedure (in short, 'CPC') for producing additional evidence to prove report A-7. According to counsel, driving licence of Pritpal Singh Ex. R2 was produced by Teja Singh, owner
