Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing of FIR No. 49 dated 26.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) registered under Section 67 of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008, Police Station Women, District Patiala and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2-complainant submits that she has no objection in quashing of impugned FIR No. 49 dated 26.04.2016 (Annexure P-2), on the basis of compromise dated 24.01.2017 arrived at between the parties before the mediation and conciliation Centre of this Court, forwarded to this Court by the Mediator.
