LISA GILL, J.

Present petition has been filed by the petitioners for protection of their life and liberty as they apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9 and other relatives because they have solemnized marriage between themselves on 31.05.2018 against the wishes of the said respondents. Both the petitioners are present in Court and on being asked submit that they have solemnized marriage between themselves out of their free will and volition. It is stated that this is their first marriage.

It is contended that the petitioners are major, their dates of birth being 03.12.1996 and 10.02.1997, respectively. True copies of Adhaar Cards of both the petitioners have been appended with the petition as Annexures P1 and P2, respectively. The photographs of the marriage and a copy of the Marriage Certificate are on record as Annexures P3 and

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P4, respectively. It is submitted that the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 01.06.2018 (Annexure P5) to respondent No.2 i.e., the Superintendent of Police, Karnal for redressal of their grievance but no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Haryana.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. S.S.Pannu DAG., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. A copy of the petition has been handed over to learned counsel for the State.

Without commenting upon the age of the petitioners or the validity of their marriage or the validity and genuineness of the certificates appended with the petition, respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Karnal, District Karnal, is directed to look into representation dated 01.06.2018 submitted by the petitioners and take appropriate action if any/as may be required keeping in view the threat perception to the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall have no effect on the validity of the alleged marriage of the petitioners and neither will any other civil or criminal proceedings initiated against the petitioners be barred due to this order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
