Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.65 dated 28.04.2018 under Sections 452/427/436/323/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

2.) This Court vide order dated 07.06.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the Investigating/Arresting Officer, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 07.06.2018, petitioner appeared before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and joined the

investigation. It is further submitted that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 07.06.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) The petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Petition stands allowed.
