Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 4.6.2018. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-3 Colly. The true typed copies of Aadhar Cards, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 2, have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 4.6.2018 (Annexure-P-4) before the police authorities for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural-respondent

No. 2, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 4.6.2018 (Annexure-P-4) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
