Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 23.5.2018. The duly sworn affidavit of petitioner No. 1 converting into Muslim Religion without any pressure has been placed on file as Annexure-P-4. The certificate of the marriage has been placed on file as Annexure-P-5. The true certified copies of Aadhar Cards, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 2, have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively. The true certified copy of receipt of Aadhar Card, showing the changed name of petitioner No. 1 from Sapna to Aaisha has been placed on file as Annexure-P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 3.6.2018 (Annexure-P-6) before the police authorities for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Mewat-Nuh, Haryana-respondent No. 1, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 3.6.2018 (Annexure-P-6) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
