This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to transfer the investigation and take appropriate speedy legal action against respondents No. 4 to 9 and other persons in FIR No. 8 dated 6.1.2017 under Sections 304-B, 34 and 498-A IPC (later added Section 302 IPC) registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurgaon.

Notice was issued in this case and status report has been filed by way of affidavit of Sumer Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Udyog Gurugram. As per the report filed, it is stated that on receipt of information that a woman named Firdosh wife of Shakir died in doubtful

circumstances, ASI Mukesh Kumar along with other police officials reached the said house where a person named Mohd. Ghani was present. Nobody from the side of in-laws was present at that time. Eventually, FIR No. 8 dated 6.1.2017 came to be registered. During the course of investigation, Shakir son of Mohd. was arrested on 7.1.2017 and a challan was prepared and thereafter Section 302 IPC was added against the accused and submitted in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate, Gurugram on 6.4.2017. The trial under the said FIR has commenced in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, after charges were framed. Attempts have also been made to apprehend the other accused namely, Umar Mohd., Jaituni, Ikram, Sajid and Shabina. Non-bailable warrants have been issued against them and various raids have been conducted by the Investigating Officer. The matter was also entrusted to the Crime Branch for further investigation and raids have been conducted to apprehend the accused persons. Eventually on 23.5.2017, the aforesaid accused have been declared as proclaimed offender by the Court of Shri Ashok Kumar, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram. Now Umar Mohd. has been arrested on 10.7.2017 and a separate case under Sections 174-A IPC has been registered against him. On 5.10.2017, accused Ikram has been arrested. As far as the other accused are concerned, efforts are being made to arrest them.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the status report.

In view of the fact that three accused already stand arrested and efforts are being made to arrest the remaining accused, no further orders are

called for.

This petition is disposed of accordingly.
