SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is an accused in F.I.R. No. 196, dated 17.11.2016, under Sections 420 and 408 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, (Annexure P-1), has prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise.

2. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for respondent No.2 that the

petitioner failed to pay up his dues in terms of the undertaking given on 31.10.2017, on account of which the present petition is liable to be rejected. It is further submitted by him that no money whatsoever was paid by the petitioner after the aforesaid order.

3. In the given circumstances, this Court finds no reason to grant any further opportunity to the petitioner, in view of the observations already recorded in the earlier order.
