The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.77 dated 28.04.2018 under Sections 306 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Contonment, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

2. This Court vide order dated 08.06.2018 had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 08.06.2018 the petitioners have joined investigation. That apart observations made by this court in the order dated 08.06.2018 have gone un rebutted.

4. In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 08.06.2018, granting ad-

interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. The petition stands allowed accordingly.
