Mr. Neeraj Yadav, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed *vakalatnama* which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Priyanka Police Station Women, Rewari, has made statement that petitioner-Mukesh in compliance of order dated 07.06.2018 passed by this Court has joined the investigation and do not oppose the grant of bail together with the fact the counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the attested/certified copies of statement of complainant-Luxmi as well as accused-Mukesh, made before the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Faridabad to the effect that the matter has since been settled between the parties.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.06.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
