RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 43 dated 27.03.2018, under Sections 341, 323, 379, 148 and 149 of the IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Division E, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise (Annexure P-2 *Colly.*) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 30.07.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Additional Chief

Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 06.08.2018. Report from the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, vide letter No. 1154 dated 07.08.2018, has been received duly forwarded by District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide Endst. No. 7467R dated 09.08.2018. According to the report of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, the compromise is genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 43 dated 27.03.2018, under Sections 341, 323, 379, 148 and 149 of the IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Division E, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
