This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the
petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.493 dated 11.5.2018,
under Sections 323, 379-B and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City

Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

The main ground taken by learned counsel for the petitioner is that the complainant and the petitioner both are neighbours and the present FIR was lodged due to some misunderstanding but now the complainant has given his affidavit, which has been placed on record as Annexure P-3, as per which the complainant has stated that he does not wish to press the case as the matter has been compromised with the petitioner who is his neighbour.

Counsel for the complainant has also accepted the fact and the learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana is also not in a position to deny that the complainant has indeed filed the said affidavit.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petition is **accepted**. The petitioner is admitted on regular bail on furnishing of his bail bonds and surety bonds subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.
