Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to carry out fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.362 dated 25.09.2014 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from the investigating officer states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has already completed the investigation and has submitted the challan. Thereafter, the trial court has framed charge on 25.05.2017 and the case is now fixed for prosecution evidence.

Considering the fact that investigation in this case is already over and nobody has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner, this Court finds that prayer of the petitioner has become infructuous as after framing of charge, case is now fixed for prosecution evidence.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
