AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had not intentionally absented himself from the proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, in which the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh, by order dated 21.03.2018. He further states that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh, on or before 19.06.2018. He further states that the petitioner gives an undertaking that in future he shall not absent himself in the proceedings before the trial Court.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh, on or before **19.06.2018** and moves an application for grant of regular bail, he shall be admitted to interim bail which shall operate till a decision is taken on the application for grant of regular bail.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
