Present petition has been filed for seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. In FIR N0.39 dated 27.03.2017 registered under Sections 15/18/21/22 of NDPS Act at Police Station Kartarpur, Distt. Jalandhar Rural.

Pursuant to the interim order dated 08.06.2018 the petitioner has already joined the investigation. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are general in nature. There is no specific attribution to the petitioner.

On instructions from ASI Amarjit Masih, learned State counsel submits that although the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, there are still two more cases against the petitioner.

To counter this submission learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is on bail in both those cases. Otherwise also, the facts of other cases have no relevance with the present case.

In view of the above submissions, without commenting upon

the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Interim order dated 08.06.2018 is made absolute.
