CRM-M-24509-2017

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.79 dated 21.06.2017, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 326, 336 and 34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 19.03.2018, report dated 15.05.2018 (in connected case i.e. CRM-M-24511-2017) has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.79 dated 21.06.2017, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 326, 336 and 34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, alongwith all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner.
