In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.3 dated 05.01.2018, (Annexure P-1) under Sections 392/395 of IPC registered at Police Station Sirsa.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case except the present one. It is also submitted that petitioner was arrested on 07.01.2018 amongst other co-accused and recovered the stolen mobile and in respect of co-accused-Amit bail has been granted on 27.02.2018 by the trial court. Therefore, he is entitled for regular bail. Challan was presented on 22.03.2018 in the trial court.

4. Having regard to the aforesaid aspects to the extent that some of the witnesses have already been examined and matter is listed for evidence on 31.07.2018, therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Deva

@ Mahanand is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

6. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.

7. The petitioner shall also appear before the Station House Officer concerned on last Saturday of every month at 10.00 am and mark his presence.
