After arguing for sometime counsel not in a position to explain as to what fresh cause of action has arisen after first petition bearing **CRM-M-21935-2018** was dismissed on 21.05.2018. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission to withdraw the petition. He is permitted to do so.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach appropriate forum.”

Once liberty has not been granted, there is no fresh cause of action as such to approach this Court and, therefore, the second petition is mis-conceived on the face of it.

At this stage when the Court is going to impose costs, counsel does not press the petition.
