The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in complaint case No. COMA-8295/2015, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted bail, however, he could not appear in the Court due to unavoidable circumstances and, therefore, his bail bonds were cancelled. Learned counsel also contends that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself without prior permission of the Court. The petitioner is willing to surrender and prefer an application for regular bail, which may be decided expeditiously.

Heard.

The petitioner had earlier been granted bail. He undertakes to surrender and appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with prior permission of the Court.

Therefore, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of one week and on his doing so, he shall prefer an application for bail, which may be decided in accordance with law expeditiously.
